Supply is available on most offerings. Tenders continue to have good supply and is the best value in chicken. The wing market is holding steady with solid supply. Breast of all sizes are readily available. Thigh and leg meat is seeing higher demand.

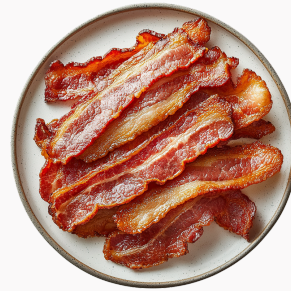

PORK

Ham has rebounded due to cleared inventories. Bellies have taken a sharp downward turn- be on the lookout for more downward pressure! Trim markets firmed up due to shorter harvest week from labor day, Rib demand remains elevated, with mixed markets- spares restrengthening. Butt and loin demand remains mixed.



GRAINS & OILS

While profit taking occurred and traders sold off some of their long position for soybean oil, the general outlook is fundamentally bullish, but likely to remain in a sideways trading range.

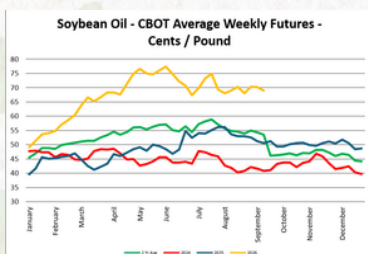
DAIRY

European Union butter prices were generally flat to slightly lower. Market inventories appear ample, contributing to ongoing price pressure.

The status for fed supplies will remain tight through year end leaving the processors to struggle with improving leverage from the cattle owners.

Market Corner

ASPARAGUS

Continued demand exceeds supplies as Mexico transitions. Inclement weather has hampered a smooth supply. Peru is also limited. All sizes affected with very few large available. Market is higher. Light supplies expected through the month of November.

AVOCADO

Mexico - supplies, quality and, demand good, and the market is steady to higher. California - supplies tight, quality good, demand good, and the market is steady to higher; season wrapping up in 2-3 weeks. Peru - supplies steady, quality good, demand fair to good, and the market is steady.

BROCCOLI

Markets is higher as supplies remain tight as insect pressure is creating lower yields this week. Quality is fair to good.

CAULIFLOWER

Market is improving. Quality is fair to good.

CILANTRO/PARSLEY

Market higher on Parsley on tighter supplies. Cilantro is remains elevated. Quality reported as good on both.

CELERY

Market mostly steady as supplies are good this week and into next. Quality is good.

SQUASH

Yellow supplies tight, quality and demand good, with the market higher. Green supplies steady, quality and demand good, with the market steady. West - Zucchini supply has improved slightly but market remains steady. Yellow is in demand exceeds.

LETTUCE ROMAINE

Romaine and heart market is higher on stronger demand and lower yields. Although disease pressure persists quality is good.

LETTUCE ICEBERG

Markets are higher as lower yields continue at the field level. Expect very light supplies through September.

CITRUS –

Lemon: Supplies good, domestic fruit quality fair, demand fair to good and the market steady. Imports arriving with good quality, good volume and spread of size; peaking on 140/165/115/200. Mexico good quality and volume, heavy to small fruit. Limes **ALERT**: Supplies are steady, majority of the volume in (New Crop) small sizes 250s/275s/230s, while larger sizes such as 110s and 150s are becoming increasingly scarce.

Oranges **ALERT**: Supplies tight, quality fair to good, demand strong, market steady. Small fruit will remain tight with increased school demand.

BELL PEPPERS

East - Green supplies tight, quality is good, demand strong and the market is higher. Red and yellow supplies are steady, quality is good, demand is good and market steady..

West - Moderate demand, steady market for green, both yellow and red show stronger markets. Quality and condition remain mixed.

RUSSET POTATOES

40-50 ct remain in lighter supply with pricing increasing on mostly those sizes. Growers in some areas are seeing larger sizes in the later harvest giving optimism to availability all season. Quality is good. Markets are steady on the smaller sizes.

ONIONS

Demand is good on all colors. Limited sunlight from fires has hampered growth in some areas making large sizes limited. Growers are hopeful to see improved sizing in the later harvest. Quality is good. Markets remains steady.

GRAPES

As the California program gets closer to an end, we are seeing some quality fall on green varieties, but over all supply and quality is fair to good on all green and red.

TOMATOES

East supplies continue to be light. Last week's wet weather slowed harvest and yields are down. Supplies are expected to continue to be snug into early September. Western supplies are light on increased demand. Markets are steady with upward pressure for Romas.

PRODUCE MARKET Updates

STRAWBERRIES

Supplies are increasing. Salinas Watsonville quality has improved. Santa Maria and Oxnard new crop are the best right now for quality and size. The weather is good in all areas. Prices are lower.

BRUSSEL SPROUTS

Market is higher as demand stronger and some quality issues at the field level are impacting yields. Expect lighter supplies the next 2 - 3 weeks.

GREEN ONIONS

The market is higher as heat and recent rain is impacting yields from the field, currently supplies are struggling to meet demand, and quality is fair to good.
